COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING

Course will train students to drive a combination vehicle (tractor trailer) with the goal of obtaining a Class-A Commercial Driver's License (CDL.) Course includes classroom instruction, track instruction and on-the-road practice driving.

ARRIVE ALIVE SAFE DRIVING CLASS

BASIC SMALL ENGINE REPAIR

Students will gain the skills needed to diagnose and repair both 2- and 4-cycle engines. This could include weed eaters, tillers, chain saws, leaf blowers, and small lawn mowers. Includes classroom instruction and hands-on experience. Class size is limited, so pre-register early!

Annual Renewal Course

Course satisfies the continuing education requirements for non-franchised auto dealers.

VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION CLASS

Course satisfies the renewal education requirements for NC auto inspectors. A Safety Inspection certification is valid for four years. The OBD2 certification is valid for two years. Please do not wait until your certification expires. Renew early.

NOTARY PUBLIC

This six-hour course and exam passage is required for persons wanting to apply for notary public commissions for the State of NC.

CONCEALED CARRY HANDGUN CERT. CLASS
