











For the week ending October 1st: 13.3 % of the 1,007 residents, tested in Beaufort County, tested positive.



















A 21 day average count reduces the weekly variability which may make it more difficult to follow the overall trend.

*June 1, 2021 used as starting point due to emergence of Delta Variant and first breakthrough case recorded




Beaufort County Case Rate among 1,000 population based on vaccination status (June 1 to Aug 31, 2021)

100 Cases; 21,367 fully vaccinated population = 4.7 per 1,000 fully vaccinated people


14 Cases; 2,115 partially vaccinated population = 6.6 per 1,000 partially vaccinated people


937 Cases; 24,175 unvaccinated population = 39.7 per 1,000 unvaccinated people








