### Situation Overview

#### Hurricane Isaias

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
<b>Marine</b>	High risk for rip currents. There is the potential for dangerous marine conditions	All coastal and nearshore waters	Rip currents through e next week. Other man conditions Monday mon through Tuesday
Wind	The threat for wind continues to increase. Potential for hurricane force winds. Downed trees, power outages possible.	Anywhere in Eastern North Carolina	Monday afternoon thro Tuesday morning
Storm Surge/ Inundation	There is the potential for storm surge inundation. Still too early to be specific.	Anywhere along the coast of Eastern North Carolina	Monday afternoon thro Tuesday morning
Tornado	There is an increasing threat for tornadoes	Anywhere in Eastern North Carolina	Monday afternoon thro Tuesday morning
Flooding Rain	There is a potential for localized flooding but the fast movement of the storm should limit the overall threat	Anywhere in Eastern North Carolina	Monday afternoon thro Tuesday morning

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








### Situation Overview

#### Hurricane Isaias



**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.



- Hurricane Isaias has current intensity of 85 mph.
- First impacts from this system are increased swell/rip current risk arriving NOW through early next week.
- Confidence in track forecast is high at this time but confidence is **medium for timing** and intensity. Small changes in track can result in big changes in expected impacts.
- Now is the time to check your hurricane **plan** and supplies. We are entering the most active portion of hurricane season. More info found at weather.gov/mhx/hurricaneprep















# High Risk For Rip Currents

### RIPCURRENTS **KNOW YOUR OPTIONS**

#### **IF CAUGHT IN A RIP CURRENT**

- Relax, rip currents don't pull you under.
- Don't swim against the current.
- Swim out of the current, then to shore.
- If you can't escape, float or tread water.
- If you need help, yell or wave for assistance.

Rip currents are powerful currents of water moving away from shore. They can sweep even the strongest swimmer away from shore. If at all possible, swim near a lifeguard.

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

- Visit the <u>Beach Forecast Page</u> (experimental) for the latest beach conditions and forecast.








# **TSWind Speed Probabilities**

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 The threat for tropical storm force winds contines to increase, especially along the coast.


 Tropical Storm conditions could begin as early as sometime Monday evening.

#### Hurricane Isaias



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
The threat for 50 knot winds is increasing, especially along the coast and over the nearshore waters.





### Earliest Reasonable Time of Arrival

#### Hurricane Isaias






- The earliest reasonable time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds is sometime Monday evening
- <u>However</u>, the most likely time this area could see Tropical Storm Force Winds will be late Monday night or early Tuesday morning



# Most Likely Time of Arrival

#### Hurricane Isaias






- The most likely time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds is late Monday night or early Tuesday morning
- However, we could see Tropical Storm Force Winds as early as sometime Monday evening



### Storm Total Rainfall

Hurricane Isaias





- Based on current track and intensity
- Localized flooding is possible where bands of the heaviest rain fall
- The highest risk areas now, may shift based on track and intensity changes
- Localized higher amounts are possible

- Based on current track and intensity
- Potential for power outages and downed trees
- The highest risk areas and expected wind speeds now, may shift based on track and intensity changes










### Maximum Wind Gust

Hurricane Isaias





- Some gusting to hurricane force possible.
- Location of highest winds and overall hurricane intensity highly dependent upon track forecast at this time and will likely change.
- Check back often for future updates.

High risk for rip currents now through early next week.

Tropical storm force winds possible as early as Monday evening, but most likely sometime late Monday night or early Tuesday morning. Potential for hurricane force winds, power outages, downed trees.



Storm surge inundation possible along the coast and local sounds/rivers.



An increasing threat for tornadoes.




Localized heavy rain possible but storm motion may limit overall threat.
