









For the week ending January 14th: 38.4% of the 1554 residents, tested in Beaufort County, tested positive.





7 Day Average




Beaufort County 21 day average case count (as of 1/21/2022)




21 Day

A 21 day average count reduces the weekly variability which may make it more difficult to follow the overall trend.














