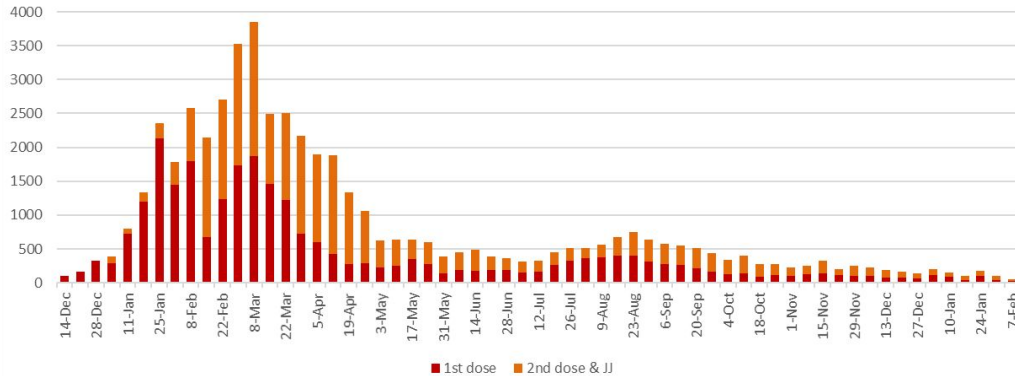

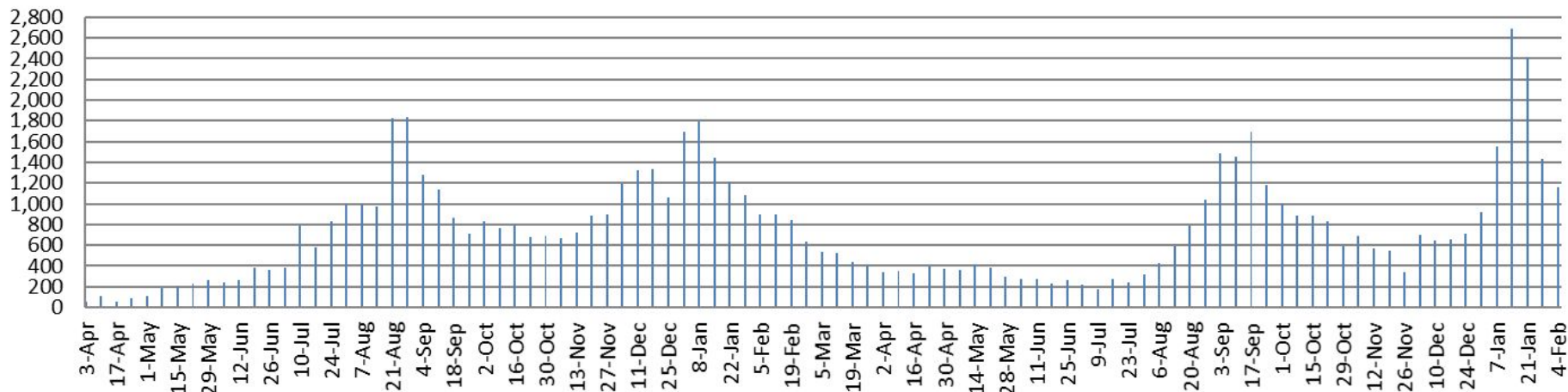

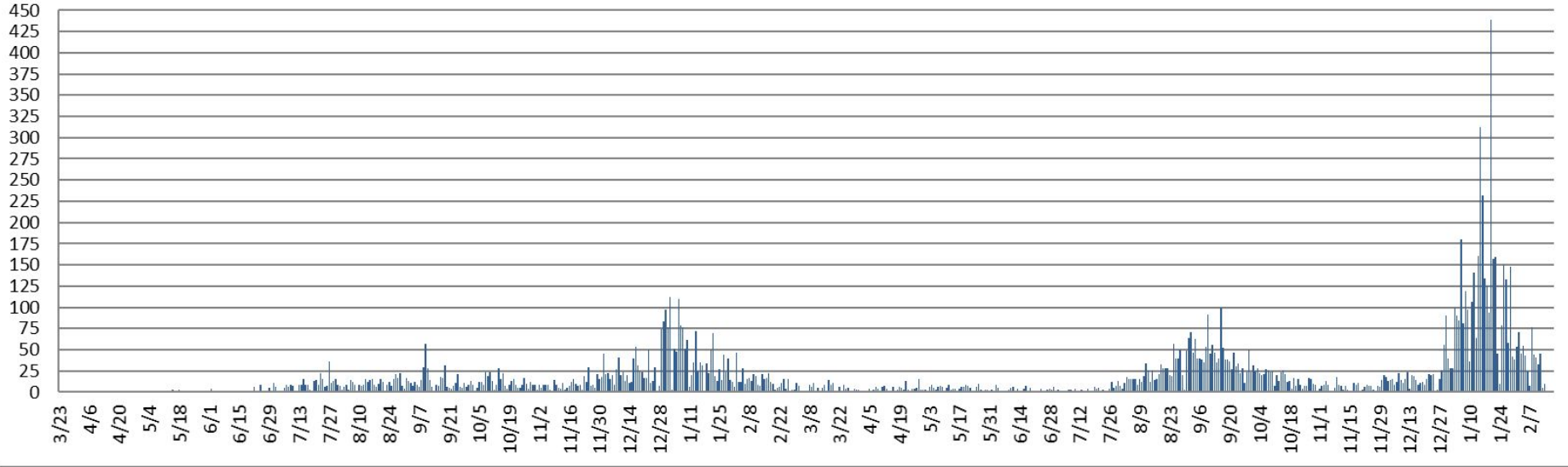

(Calculated weekly) as of 2/4/2022**

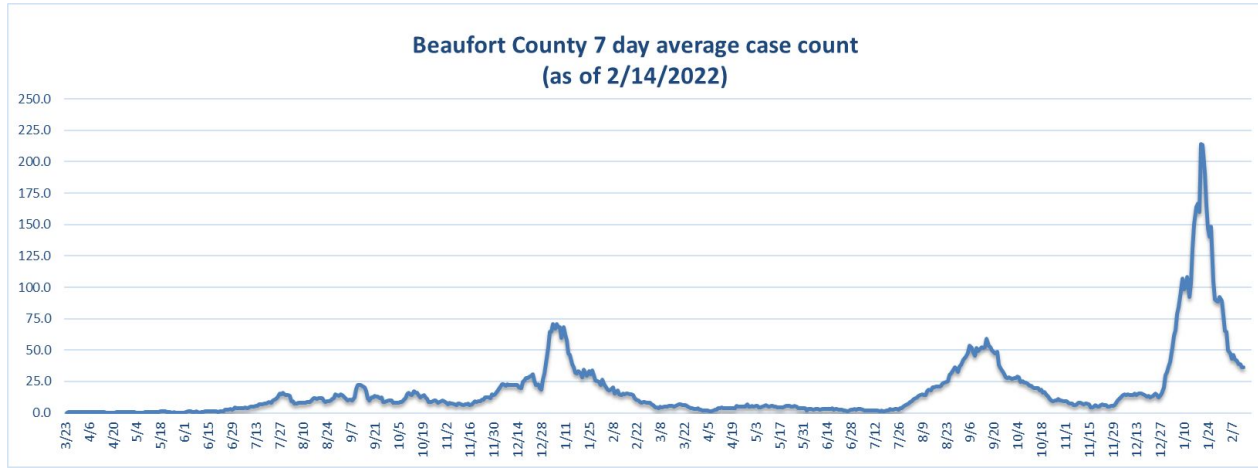

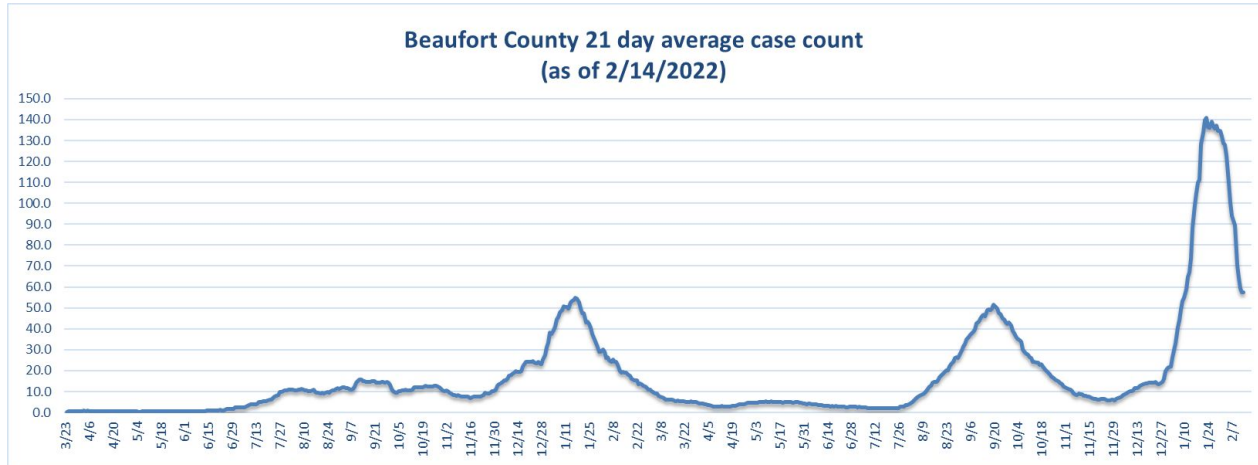
Beaufort County daily case count timeline (as of 2/14/2022)

21 Day Average

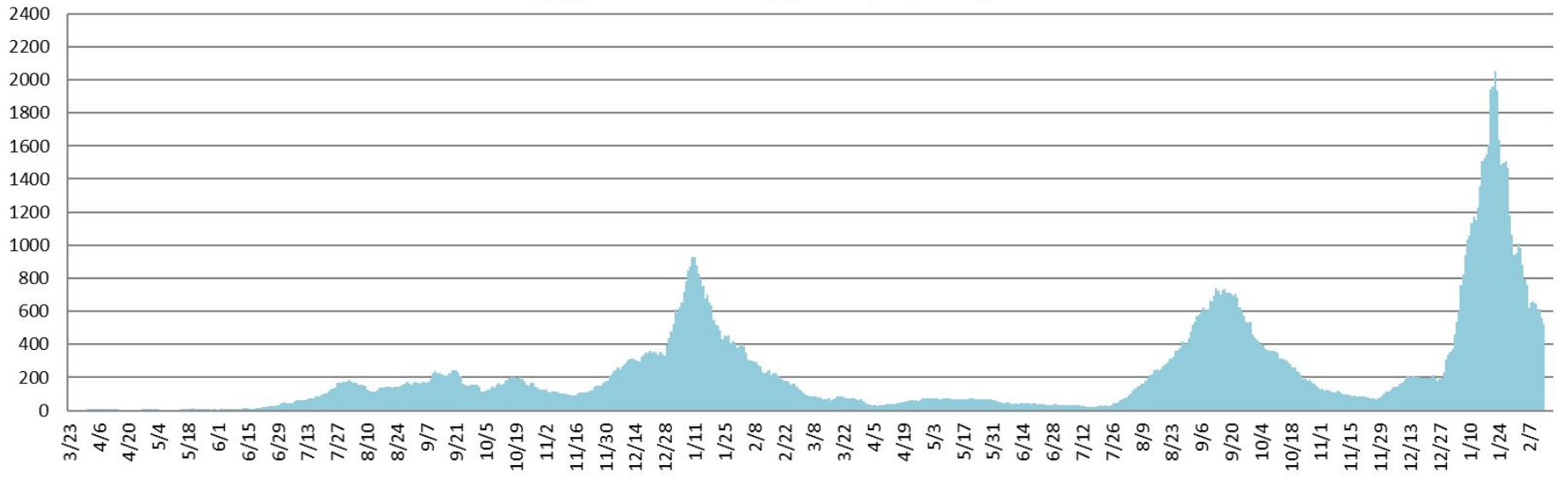


A 21 day average count reduces the weekly variability which may make it more difficult to follow the overall trend.

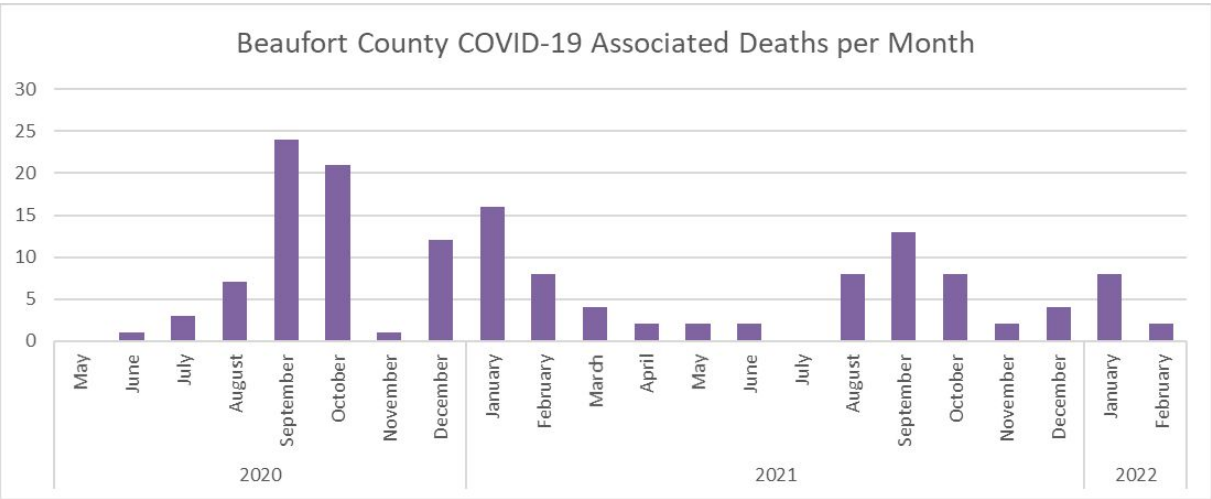
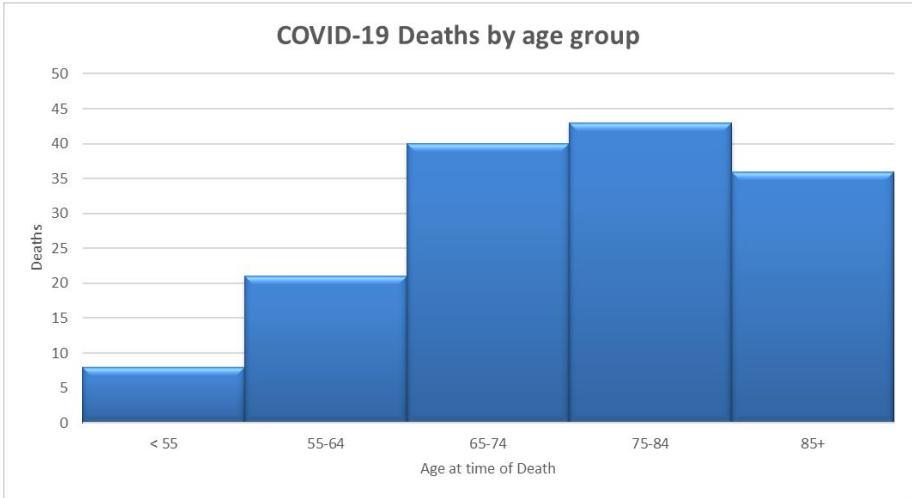
Beaufort County 7 day average case count 7/1/2021 to 2/14/2022

Beaufort County Associated Deaths (148 total)



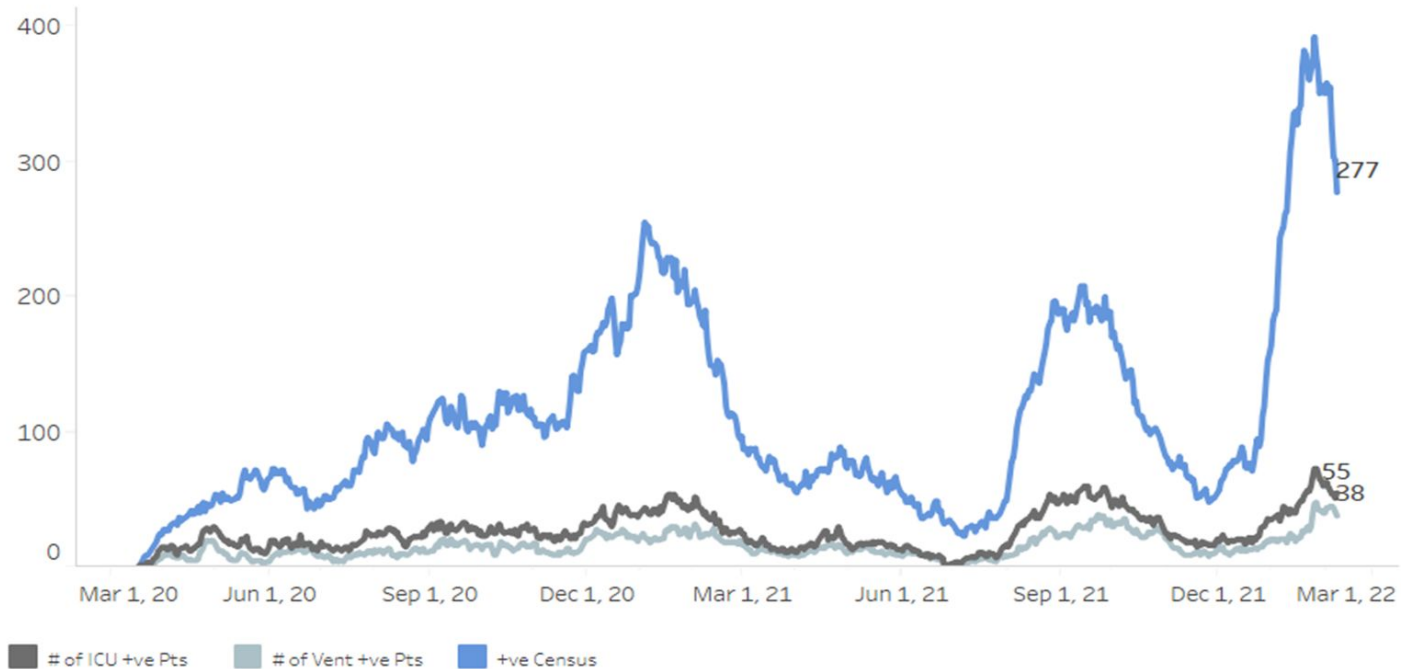
