

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>This period is used to determine influence of Omicron Variant on County















For the week ending February 11th: 23.5% of the 792 residents, tested in Beaufort County, tested positive.











### 7 Day Average










A 21 day average count reduces the weekly variability which may make it more difficult to follow the overall trend.
