









For the week ending February 4th: 27.6% of the 1154 residents, tested in Beaufort County, tested positive.











7 Day Average









A 21 day average count reduces the weekly variability which may make it more difficult to follow the overall trend.








Beaufort County Associated Deaths (147 total)
