8am Situational Report

Current Weather Conditions

- The heaviest rains have passed and slowly moving off the Outer Banks. Widely scattered light rain is expected to continue through 11am.
- The Tornado Watch has been cancelled for our area.
- Our current wind conditions are expected to continue through 4pm this afternoon before slowly reducing.
- Most of our shorelines are experiencing 2 to 3 feet of surge.

Infrastructure

- There have been no reports of any roads being closed or flooded.
 - Currently Reported Power Outages Include
 - o Duke Energy
 - 202 outages along Hwy 33 in Chocowinity between Old Blounts Creek Rd and Wollard Rd.
 - o Tideland Electric
 - 12 outages on Windmill Rd in Chocowinity (Off Old Blounts Creek Rd)
 - 7 Outages on River Acres Rd in Washington (Off River Rd).
- *Belhaven was without power this morning, but it has since been restored.**
No outages have been reported in Washington.
- No water system disruptions have been reported.

Storm Related Emergency Calls

- There have been no significant calls for service related to this storm.
- There have been no reports of damaged structures.
