





- ✓ A few tornadoes are possible, resulting in areas of enhanced damage.






### **Chance that Rain Ends as Snow**

## **Event Summary**

# Threats for Severe Weather, Strong Winds, Coastal Flooding Early Saturday morning through Saturday afternoon



Strong, damaging winds in thunderstorms could lead to structural damage, trees down/uprooted, and power outages.



A few tornadoes are possible, resulting in areas of enhanced damage.



Minor coastal flooding expected for soundside Outer Banks. Additionally beach erosion and possible ocean overwash will be a threat from Oregon Inlet to Surf City.



Wind gusts 45-55 mph expected along the Outer Banks, with wind gusts 40-50 mph expected elsewhere along the coast.



Drastically colder weather overnight into Sunday morning with wind chills in the teens
