Strong Coastal Low to Impact Eastern NC Sunday into Monday



OVERVIEW

A strong low pressure system will impact Eastern NC Sunday and Monday, bringing the potential for strong winds, heavy rain, minor coastal flooding, and dangerous marine conditions.



TIMING

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Sunday and Monday
 - Areas of heavy rainfall will bring the potential for localized minor flooding to poor drainage areas
 - Strong/gusty winds could blow around light unsecured objects such as holiday decorations and cause isolated power outages.
 - Coastal impacts: Minor coastal flooding possible (soundside and oceanside). Minor ocean overwash possible.
 - Dangerous marine conditions will exist across all waterways.

While the timing of the low is coming into better

focus, the strength and track of the low, and thus the wind and coastal flooding threat, remain moderately uncertain at this time.

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
