
Severe Thunderstorm Risk through Tonight - Timing

KEYTIMING MESSAGES

- The most likely timing is shown below
- The severe weather risk is expected to linger well into the night
- Nighttime severe weather can be especially dangerous



HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging winds of 50-70 mph (possible areawide)
- Large hail of penny to golf ball size (greatest hail risk is in the blue-shaded area)
- A tornado or two (possible areawide, but in general, the tornado risk is lower with this event)
- Isolated to scattered instances of flash flooding (possible areawide)
