


Severe Weather Threat Tuesday



OVERVIEW

Showers and thunderstorms will develop ahead of an approaching cold front Tuesday afternoon. Several of these thunderstorms could become strong to severe.



Initial storm development takes place across northeast NC and the inner Coastal Plain, with storms spreading toward the coast later in the afternoon.

Overall severe weather threat is similar across all of ENC.

TIMING

- Initial storms develop early to mid afternoon. Severe threat diminishes after sunset.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- The strongest storms will bring the threat for strong wind gusts, with tree and structural damage, as well as localized power outages, possible. Additionally, large hail (greater than quarter size) is possible with the strongest storms.
