

Severe Weather Threat Today – May 9, 2023



OVERVIEW

Scattered to numerous strong to severe thunderstorms are expected to develop this afternoon and evening. Damaging winds will be the primary threat.

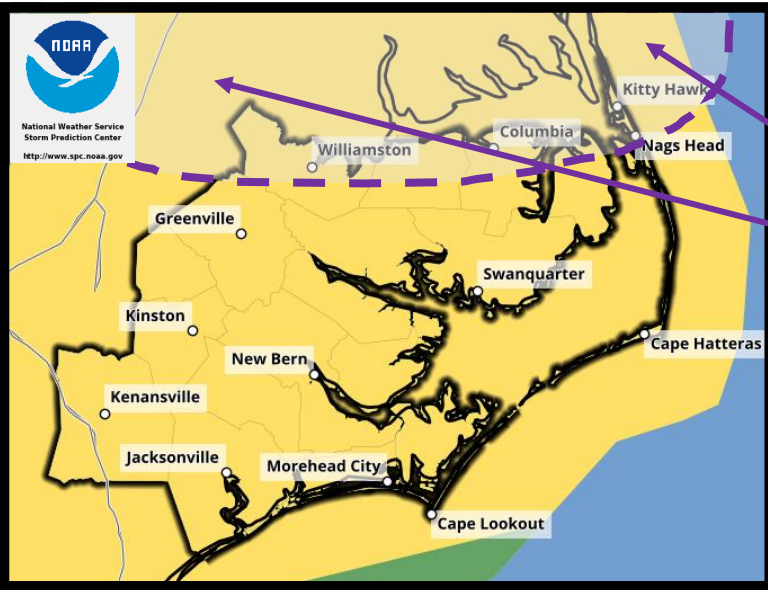
TIMING

- Greatest severe weather risk will be between **3pm – 10pm**

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging winds of 55-65 mph, capable of tree and structure damage, and power outages
- If a larger complex / line of thunderstorms develops, there could be an enhanced risk of more widespread damaging winds
- Hail of penny to half-dollar size
- The tornado threat is **VERY LOW**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



Initial storm development takes place across northeast NC, with storms spreading south toward the coast through early evening.

Overall severe weather threat is similar across all of ENC.
